Townhall Meeting Proposition 2 Medical Marijuana

We are holding a legislative townhall meeting on **Thursday, October 4, 2018** to discuss Proposition 2, The Utah Medical Cannabis Act, a ballot initiative that will be on your November ballot this year.

Proposition 2, The Utah Medical Cannabis Act, is 26 pages long and complex. It is not a simple proposition (see link at the bottom of this page).

This townhall meeting will consist of a panel discussion regarding medical cannabis with a focus on Proposition 2 and what this initiative does, and what it does not do.

The panel discussion will be followed by an opportunity for moderated questions and comments from the public if time permits.

Panel participants will include:

- Representative Edward Redd – Utah House District 4, and local physician
- Lee Edwards – attorney – Cache County Attorney’s Office
- Desiree Hennessy – a signed sponsor of the Utah Medical Cannabis Act (Proposition 2)
- Christine Stenquist – President and founder of TRUCE Utah, a medical cannabis advocacy non-profit organization, a signed sponsor of the Utah Medical Cannabis Act (Proposition 2)
- Justin Arriola – Navy Veteran, civil and mechanical engineer, Utah resident – activist with Americans for Safe Access – works with TRUCE Utah
- Alex Iorg – Campaign Manager – Utah Patient’s Coalition
- Thomas Paskett – Board Chair and Policy Director – TRUCE Utah

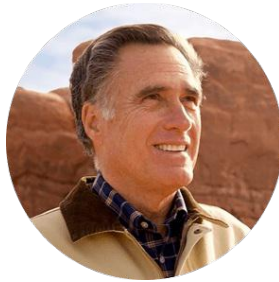

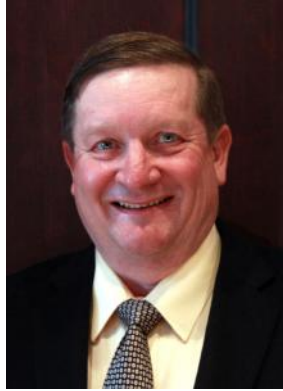
