Treasurer: John Drew - Cache GOP currently has \$27,000 in the bank

Elected Officials

- County Executive David Zook: public safety, mental health, fixing the problems created by JRI, transportation, preserve open space/housing task force should have report ready by June 23rd
- County Attorney John Luthy: one of the duties of the county attorney is to educate the public on community's standards by the way they prosecute; Cache currently has 3 district courts
- Sheriff Chad Jensen: Sheriff's association passed bills to help fix the justice system;
 officers continue to feel community support here in our valley
- County Clerk/Auditor Jess Bradfield: 1.1% undeliverable historically it's been 6%; track
 your ballot here: https://ballottrax.utah.gov/voter/; law to block party switching for
 primaries is working cannot switch affiliation after March 31st; ballot processing center ask for a tour; poll watching is welcome; Cache is designing ballot box with integrated
 camera footage will be reviewed only if a problem arises
- Representative Casey Snider: passed a bi-partisan tax relief bill; continue with conservative fiscal policies
- Representative Petersen: purpose of government is to secure rights, can't be afraid to speak truth, citizens job is to keep government falling into error
- State Board Member Jennie Earl: reach out to her for help, any questions, she will help you talk to local boards; <u>HB374</u> was passed to remove explicit books in schools; currently working on the revised Social Studies Standards, which are not adequate need to include more Constitution & principles
